## HOLISTIC APPROACH TO **PERSONALITY DEVELOPMENT**

The ecolea | Internationale Schule Rostock is a state-approved grammar school. Key features of our school are its all-day learning provision, bilingual teaching and a strong focus on foreign language teaching, exchange programmes with various European schools and strong integration into the region's economic and societal structures.

Teaching at ecolea is based on the use of didactic approaches that open up individual learning opportunities for each student. We encourage self-directed learning, we have an open and transparent school culture with clear structures, rules and responsibilities, and we focus on action-oriented teaching - all these things help the students at ecolea to develop well-rounded personalities.

The atmosphere at the school is shaped by a strong feeling of community and by rituals and traditions that create a sense of identity and a culture of recognition, with the result that all our students feel very much at home here. Our aim is not only to impart knowledge but also to foster the development of self-confident, mature individuals who behave responsibly and make a positive contribution to society. Our school is a place of mutual understanding, intercultural learning and tolerance.

## School-leaving exams at ecolea **MUCH MORE THAN ABITUR**

At ecolea Rostock, grammar school education starts in Year 5. We want to see all the young people in our school through to their "Abitur" examinations (equivalent to the British A-level). Students who want to leave our grammar school at the end of Year 10 can gain the "Mittlere Reife" gualification (equivalent to the British GCSE). Students who successfully complete Year 11 are awarded the school-based part of the "Fachhochschulreife" (entrance requirement for a university of applied sciences). As a state-approved alternative school, we are responsible for organising and running all the examinations that we offer in our school.

#### CertiLingua Label of Excellence

In addition to the various state-approved school-leaving qualifications, students at ecolea Rostock can also obtain internationally recognised foreign language certificates in English, French, Spanish and Swedish. These include the Cambridge Certificate, the Diplôme d'études de langue francaise (DELF), the Diploma de Español como Lengua Extranjera (DELE), and the SWEDEX Certificate. Students can gain the CertiLingua® Label of Excellence if they have shown evidence in their Abitur course of having particular skills on a European or international level.



## A CHARMING LOCATION

With its diverse natural landscape and fascinating history, the location of our school in Rostock-Warnemünde provides a unique environment where we can really bring the subject matter of our lessons to life for our students.

In the school building too, our students can look forward to finding a friendly and motivating learning atmosphere. The modular design of our "flexible classroom" concept allows us to switch easily from group work to individual activities. The use of interactive whiteboards and a digital learning platform expand the range of methodological and didactic options that are open to us.

Multi-functional rooms for specialist subjects provide firstclass conditions for practical work and allow students to carry out experiments independently in their science lessons. In the Learning Centre, which integrates both traditional and digital media, students are encouraged to learn independently and practise giving freestyle presentations. And in our two sports halls there is plenty of space for extended sports lessons, sports breaks and various different sports-based offerings in the afternoons.

## CONTRIBUTION TO SCHOOL FEES

Private schools are generally financed through two sources of income - firstly through state subsidies for alternative schools and secondly through the fees that parents pay for their child to attend the school.

Registration fee	€ 100 one-off fee
School fees (Year 5 - 8)	€ 270 per month
School fees (Year 9 - 12)	<b>€ 285</b> per month
Hire fee for school books	<b>€ 60</b> per year

In addition to the fees listed above, there will also be costs to pay for lunches, day trips and class trips and for teaching materials. There may also be further fees to pay if your child takes up any of our optional additional offerings (e.g. language examinations).
